Attendance



- Students cannot miss more than 5 rehearsals without prior approval
 - Conflicts on audition form approved **until April**
 - Illness does not count against these if I m made aware before rehearsal starts
- Let me know if a student is sick and it won't count against
- Please help your kids be at rehearsal when scheduling appointments, etc.

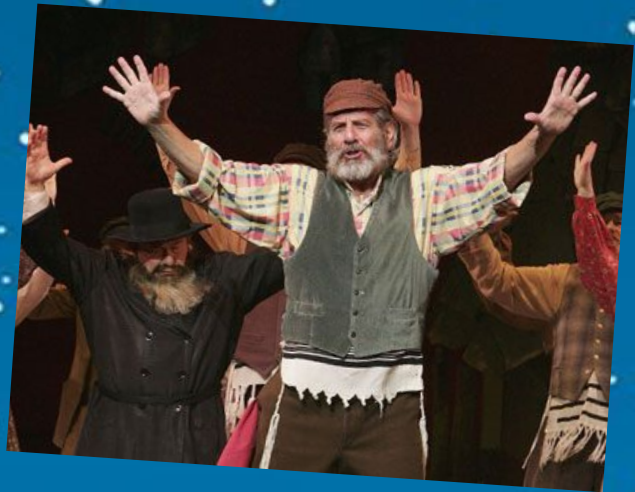
