Hotel

- ★ Student rooms: 2 queen beds & pullout
- ★ 4-5 students per room
- ★ Students only allowed in their assigned rooms.
Cannot enter another room regardless of gender.
- ★ No students alone in rooms
- ★ Can be in common areas with other students, so long as they stay in groups of 2+
 - Westlake High, and Westlake Dance in same hotel as well

Travel Rules

I agree to the following terms:

1. I understand that I am expected to abide by the laws of the city, state or country in which I am staying. I understand that I am expected to abide by all rules developed by the sponsor or organization in addition to the rules listed in this code of conduct plus any other policies or regulations established by the Alpine School District.
